- 7. What role did Jesus Christ have in God's plan to choose us?
- 8. Why does Peter also call his readers *strangers* in the world?
- 9. In what sense are we also *strangers* in the world?

- What does it mean to live as *strangers in the world*? Give some practical examples.
- How can the recognition that we are chosen sojourners help us to persevere in serving Christ joyfully and wholeheartedly?

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
