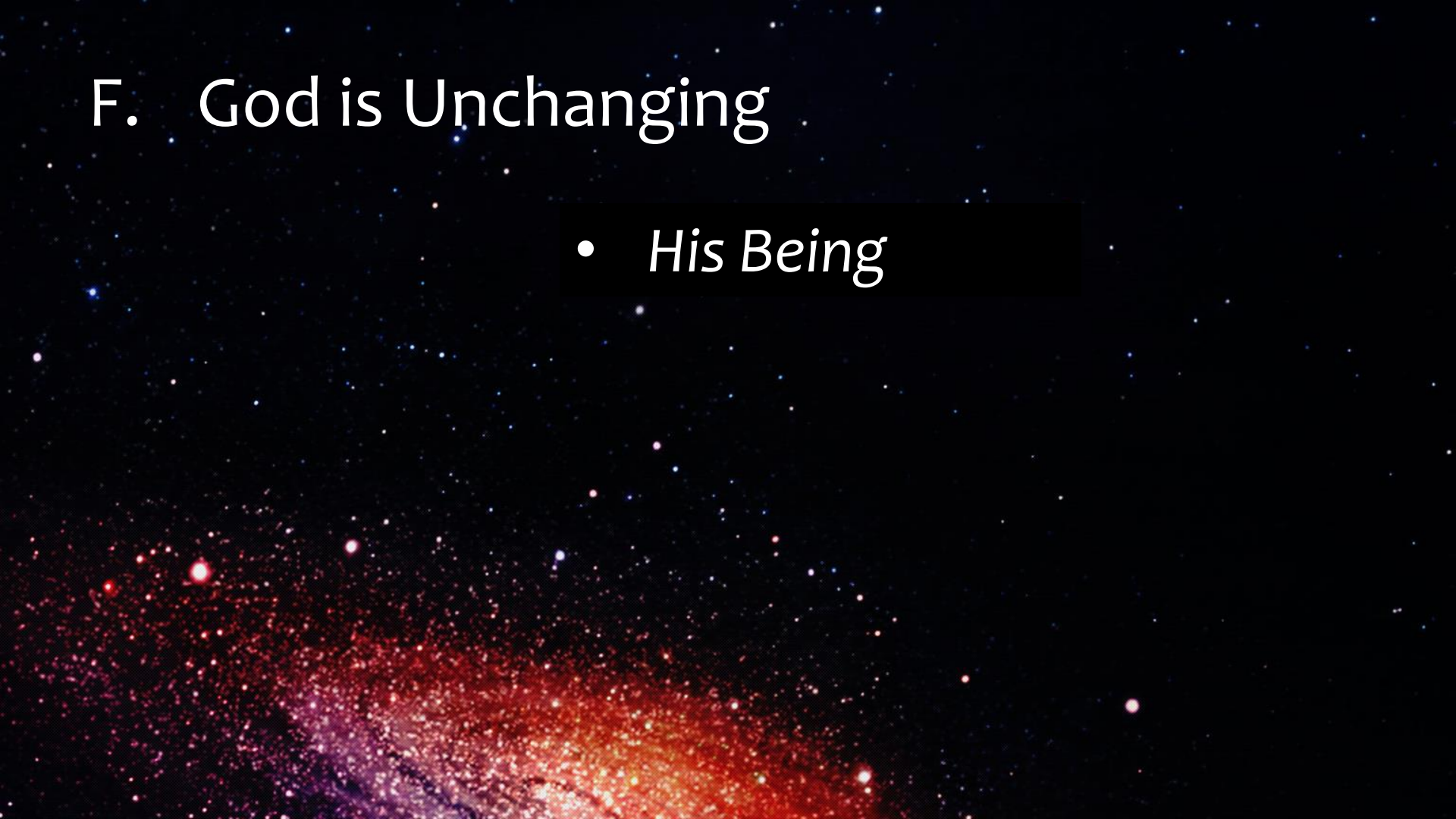


Psalm 102:25-27
