1. **Read Jeremiah 32:17.** What does this verse tell us about God's power?
2. **Read Isaiah 40:12.** What point is Isaiah making in this verse?
3. How does Isaiah emphasize God's power in **vv. 21-24**?
4. **Read Isaiah 40:25-26.** How does Isaiah help us realize how powerful God is in these verses?
5. **Read Isaiah 40:27-31.** How can meditating on God's awesome power be an encouragement to us in our daily lives?
6. **Read Numbers 13:1-20.** What mission was given to the tribal leaders?
7. What reason did the Israelites have to believe that God could actually give them the land of Canaan? Scan Exodus chs. 7-20 and jot down some of the displays of divine power that they had experienced or observed.
8. **Read Numbers 13:21-25.** What evidence did they bring back from their scouting mission? What was its significance?
9. **Read Numbers 13:26-33.** What was the report of the 10 spies?
10. **Read Numbers 14:1-9.** What was the report of Joshua and Caleb? Why was their report different than that of the other 10?
