1. What event has happened in your life that changed your perspective?
2. As you look at Habakkuk Chapter 1, verses 1-4, are there some issues that concerned him that can be applicable to the current situation in our country?
3. What was the Lord's response to Habakkuk's questions? (1:5-11)
4. What do you think about that response?
5. In Habakkuk 1:12 - 2:1, what was his reasoning for not liking the Lord's answer to his prayers? (Do we always agree with the way the Lord answers our prayers?)
6. How did the Lord then respond to Habakkuk's questioning his answer? (See 2:3,14 and 20.)
7. Since none of the situations Habakkuk saw in Chapter 1, verses 1-4 changed, what caused Habakkuk to pray and worship as recorded in Chapter 3?
8. What causes you to worship and thank the Lord?
9. How does Chapter 3, verses 16-19 fit your (our) situation today? How do you apply it to yourself?
