**Getting Started**

**Read Eph 6:10-18.** What would you say is the key idea?

**Digging In**

1. **Read 6:10-13.** What is the basic command in v. 10? Put this command in your own words.
2. Practically speaking, what does it mean to *be strong in the Lord*? What steps can we take to be strong *in his mighty power*?
3. What measure of God's *incomparably great power* is given in Eph 1:18-21? How does this relate to Eph 6:10-13?
4. What do you think it means to *put on the full armor of God*?
5. What is the fundamental **purpose** of God's armor? **Why** does Paul exhort us to *put on the full armor of God*? (vv. 11 & 13)
6. **Read Genesis 3:1-7.** What *schemes* of the devil do you see in this passage? How did he manage to get Adam and Eve to sin?
7. **Read Eph 4:25-27.** What scheme of the devil does Paul allude to in these verses?
8. How does Eph 6:12 help us realize that – ultimately – our struggle is not horizontal, but vertical?
9. What does it mean to stand our ground? (v. 13)  
(See 1 Peter 5:8-9)



**Getting Personal**

- What are some of the devil's schemes today? In what ways does he try to keep us from knowing, loving and obeying God? Name at least five.
