- 5. Why do you think Herod "called the Magi secretly"? (v. 7)
- 6. How did the Magi respond when they found the Christ? (9-12)
- 7. Read 13-18. Why was Joseph instructed to go to Egypt?
- 8. How was the return of Jesus from Egypt like the calling of the nation of Israel from Egypt in the Old Testament? (14-15)
- 9. What did Herod do when he discovered he'd been outwitted?
- 10. Read 19-23. How did God direct Joseph back to Israel? (cf. 1:20 and 2:13)
- 11. Why didn't Joseph settle in Judea?
- 12. How is God's sovereignty (God's control) seen in this chapter?
