1. **Read Matthew 7:13-14**. Describe the two options that Jesus gives in these verses. What are the final consequences of the two choices?



- 2. **Read Matthew 7:15-20**. Jesus says we'll recognize false prophets by their fruit. What does he mean by that? What kind of *fruit* would be evidence of a false prophet?
- 3. Explain the two trees that Jesus describes. What's the main point he's trying to make?
- 4. **Read Matthew 7:21-23**. What kind of person will enter the kingdom of heaven? What does it mean to enter the kingdom of heaven?
- 5. How can it be that some people will be able to do many impressive religious things, but will not be able to enter the kingdom?
- 6. What are some examples of empty religiosity today?
- 7. **Read Matthew 7:24-29**. What is the essential difference between the two builders?
- 8. How can we follow the example of the wise man who built his house upon the rock?
