- 5. How are Christ's compassion and power seen in this passage?

- 7. Have you ever seen a Where's Waldo? book? Can you find yourself in these verses?
- 8. **Read Matthew 8:14-17**. How are Christ's power and compassion seen in these verses?
- 9. **Read Matthew 8:18-22**. Do you think the first questioner was sincere? Why or why not?
- 10. What point was Jesus' making in his reply to this man?
- 11. According to these verses, how is there a cost to following Jesus?
