- 4. If you had been one of the disciples, how do you think you would have reacted to the storm?
- 5. How did Jesus respond to the disciples' cry for help? What does this reveal about his expectations for his disciples?
- 6. What does Jesus' command of nature reveal about his identity?
- 7. **Read Matthew 8:28-34**. Tell the story in your own words.
- 8. Reflect for a moment on the condition of the two men. List the ways in which they were suffering.
- 9. What do you think the demons meant in v. 29?
- 10. Why do you think Jesus allowed the demons to go into the pigs?
- 11. What was the reaction of the people who witnessed the destruction of the pigs?
- 12. What was the reaction of the townspeople? Why?
- 13. What does Jesus' authority over demons reveal about his identity?
