- 4. **Read Matthew 9:18-26**. Who is this ruler? (Cf. Mark 5:22)
- 5. How does the synagogue ruler demonstrate faith in Jesus?
- 6. What happened to Jesus on the way to Jairus' house?
- 7. What was the woman's problem? (Cf. Mark 5:25-26 for details)
- 8. How did the woman demonstrate faith in Jesus?
- 9. Why did the crowd laugh at Jesus when he finally arrived at Jairus' house?
- 10. **Read Matthew 9:27-31**. How did the blind men address Jesus?
- 11. Why do you think Jesus asked them if they believed he could heal them?
- 12. What role did faith have in the healing of the blind men, and in the healing of the woman who had been subject to bleeding?
- 13. **Read Matthew 9:32-34**. What did Jesus do for the man who couldn't talk?
- 14. What did the Pharisees conclude about Jesus' power & authority? What does Matthew want his readers to conclude?
