- 1. **Read Matthew 11:20-24.** Locate Korazin, Bethsaida and Capernaum on a map of Palestine in the back of your Bible. (Hint: find a map of Jesus' Ministry and look near the Sea of Galilee.)
- 2. Why did Jesus denounce these cities?
- 3. Can you think of some miracles that Jesus performed in these cities? (cf. 8:5-17; 9:2-8)
- 4. Why would Tyre, Sidon and Sodom be judged less severely than Korazin, Bethsaida and Capernaum? What is the relevance of this for us today?
- 5. Describe genuine repentance.
- 6. Read Matthew 11:25-27. From whom does God conceal truth? Why?
- 7. To whom does God reveal truth? Why?
- 8. What does v. 27 reveal about Jesus' relationship with the Father? What does it reveal about Jesus' authority?
- 9. Read Matthew 11:28-30. Why were the people weary and burdened?
- 10. What does it mean for a person to take Jesus' yoke upon himself or herself? What will be the result?
- 11. Why is Jesus' yoke not burdensome?

- Is Jesus an add-on to your own life, or does he own your life?
- Have you taken up Jesus' yoke?
- Are you experiencing the rest that Jesus promised?
