- 7. **Read Matthew 13:57**. How else did they respond to Jesus *wisdom* and *miraculous powers*?
- 8. What do you think Jesus meant by his statement in the latter part of v. 57?
- 9. **Read Matthew 13:58**. Why didn't Jesus do many miracles in Nazareth? (cf. Mark 6:4-6)
- 10. Why was Moses slow to trust God to use him. (Exodus 3-4)
- 11. How did God respond to Moses' lack of faith?
