Digging In

- 1. **Read Matthew 15:1-2.** Why were the Pharisees and teachers of the law upset with Jesus? What was the problem?
- 2. **Read Matt 15:3-6.** Write a paraphrase of Jesus' response in verse 3.
- 3. How were the religious leaders putting a greater emphasis on keeping their tradition than in obeying the law of God?
- 4. Can you think of examples of how we are in danger of doing this today?
- 5. **Read Matt 15:7-9**. How does Jesus use the quote from Isaiah 29:13 to illustrate the hypocrisy of the Pharisees and teachers of the law?
- 6. **Read Matt 15:10-14**. Why were the Pharisees like plants that will be uprooted?
- 7. How were they like blind guides?

- 8. **Read Matt 15:15-18**. In verse 15, the disciples refer to Jesus' statement in v. 11 as a parable. How does Jesus explain this *parable* in vv. 17-18? What is his main point?
- 9. **Read Matt 15:19-20**. How does Jesus illustrate his point in these two verses?
- 10. How does this list of sins compare with the 10 Commandments? (cf. Exod 20:3-17)
- 11. How does hypocrisy tend to creep into the church?
