- 5. What was Jesus' second question? Paraphrase Peter's answer.
- 6. **Read Matthew 16:17-20**. Jesus calls Peter *blessed*. In what specific way was Peter blessed?
- 7. Jesus said that Peter would have a key role in the foundation of the Church. What do you think Jesus meant? (Cf. Peter's actions and influence in Acts chs. 1-12.)
- 8. In what way is Jesus the ultimate foundation of the Church? (Cf. 1 Cor 3:11; Eph 2:19-20)



- 9. **Read Matthew 16:18 again**. What does this verse tell us about Christ's relationship with the Church?
- 10. Give some examples of how Jesus is building his Church today.
- 11. How can we cooperate with Jesus in the building of His church?
