- 2. What does Jesus predict will happen to him in Jerusalem?
- 3. If you had been there, how do you think you would have responded to Jesus' prophecy in v. 21? Why?
- 4. Why do you think Peter contradicts Jesus in v. 22?
- 5. Why does Jesus respond to Peter so harshly in v. 23?
- 6. What did Jesus mean that Peter had in mind the things of men rather than the things of God?
- 7. How can we obstruct the purposes of God in the same way today?
- 8. **Read Matthew 16:24-28**. What are the requirements for anyone who wants to become a disciple of Christ? Explain each of the phrases in v. 24.
- 9. How can a person lose his life by saving it? (v. 25)
- 10. How can a person find life by losing it? (v. 25)
- 11. How does Jesus emphasize his point in v. 26?
- 12. How can Jesus' prophecy in v. 27 help us to follow Christ wholeheartedly now?
